AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE # 92 SECTION 92.03

SECTION 92.03: LEASH REQUIREMENTS.

It shall be unlawful for any owner, keeper, or person in charge of a dog or any animal to permit or allow the dog or the animal to stray or go beyond the premise of its owner, keeper, or custodian, unless the dog or the animal is held properly in leash. The maximum leash length shall be 5feet in length. (1993 Code3.2) Penalty, see 92.99

AMENDMENT.

It shall be unlawful for any owner, keeper, or person in charge of a dog or any animal to permit or allow the dog or the animal to stray or go beyond the premise of its owner, keeper, or custodian, unless the dog is held properly in leash. The maximum leash length shall be 5 feet in length. It shall also be unlawful for any person who, while walking or escorting a dog, or any animal on a leash to allow such animal to deposit feces on public or private property, other than the property of the animal's owner, or the property of the person walking or escorting the animal, without

immediately removing such feces and deposit same in a suitable refuse disposal container or upon the property of the person.

Any person owning a dog, or any other animal, whether or not on a leash, which deposits feces on public or private property, other than the property of the animal's owner shall upon being made aware of such fact, immediately remove such feces and properly dispose of same in a suitable refuse disposal container or upon the property of that person.
